

NONVIOLENT CRISIS INTERVENTION (NCI)

Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (NCI) training is for primary caregivers, educators and human service professionals who directly intervene in crisis situations, teaching staff de-escalation techniques, as well as restrictive and non-restrictive interventions.

Students are required to have non-violent crisis intervention until the last day of their field placement that is valid until:

April 30 for AUT1

August 31 for AUT3 full-time

**If Part-time – must be valid your entire placement.

This can be from a course you take at your workplace or from the below suggested courses. Please note that if you are currently certified and it will expire before the above dates, bringing your current certificate plus an email/letter from your organization that you will be provided the re-certification is acceptable.

The acceptable certificates are:

- Crisis Prevention Institute (NVCPI)
- Safe Management Group (SMG)
- Prevention and Management of Aggressive Behaviours (PMAB) **will no longer be available to be re-trained in
- Behaviour Management Solutions (BMS)

Note:

Normally, there is a training component, as well as the physical component. There is a 'learning part' and then a 'hands-on' part (usually the hands-on part is called physicals). Normally it is required that you obtain both. During COVID, students are permitted to have certification with "no physicals." Just please be aware that your certificate will state this and some field placements may require it. Please see below for options.

Where Can you Gain Your Certificate?

1. SAFE MANAGEMENT GROUP

– Initial Crisis Intervention Training (*or refresher if you are currently certified*)

Online (offers both the initial training & the physicals) * see note above about physical training
