In 1978, Barry was part of the team that was responsible for securing Canada's first campus instructional radio station, CIXX-FM which was dedicated to training students under actual broadcast conditions. For these activities and his teaching, Barry was honoured in 2003 as one of the first inductees into the Fanshawe College Wall of Fame for the School of Contemporary Media.

Barry was proud of his teaching career, was pleased to receive many updates on students' careers, or offer advice to many students, years after they had graduated from the program.
