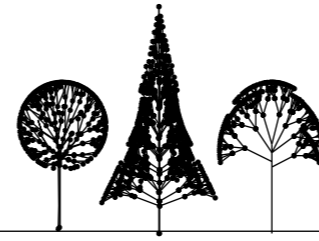


TURNING POINT

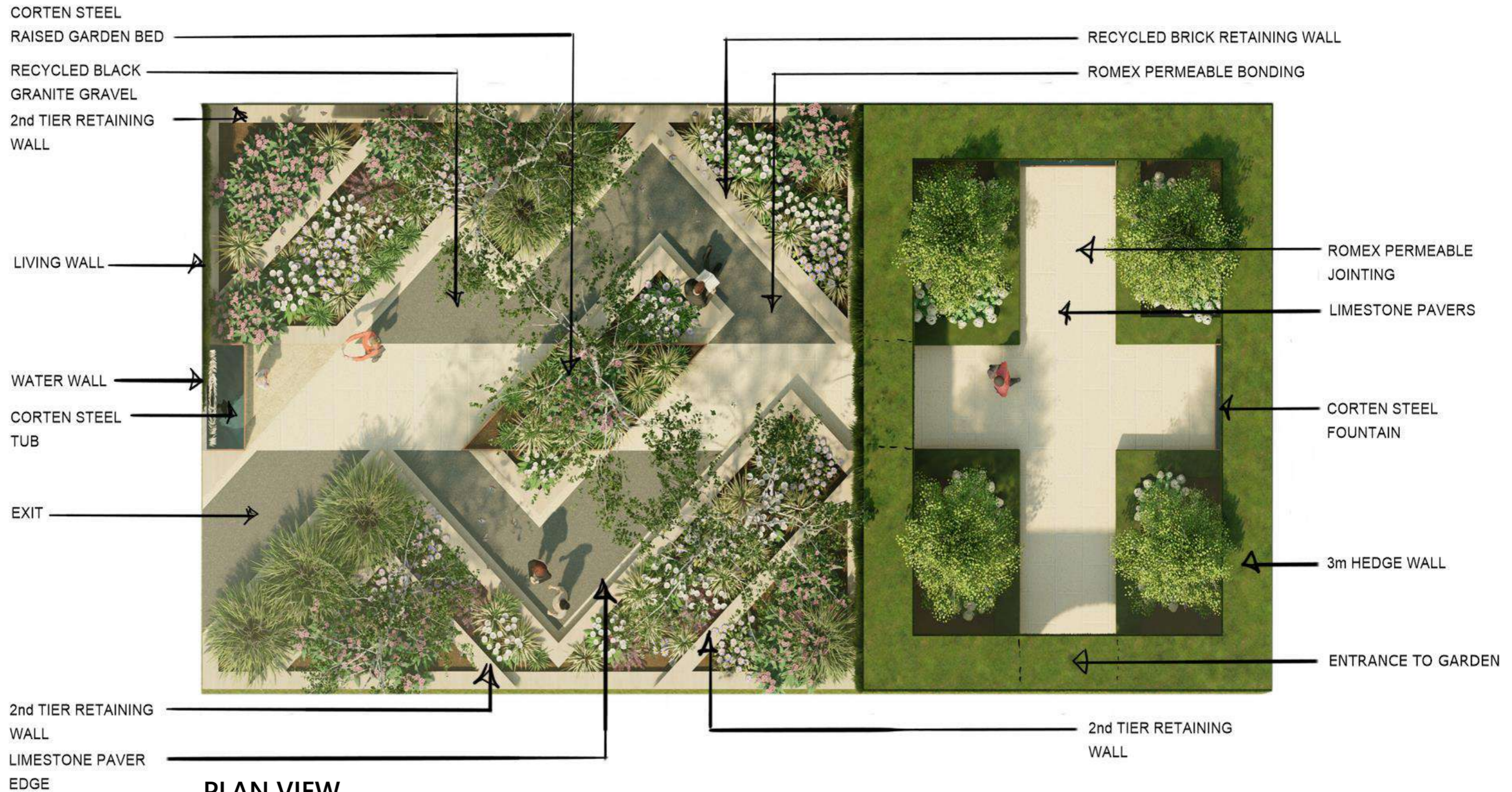

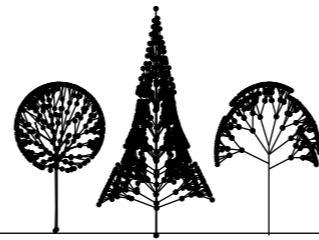
