College Policy Changes: JANUARY 2025

College Policy Manual Changes for January 15, 2025

A128 Student Academic Appeals

Amended: Dec. 18, 2024 (CC-24-03)

This policy has been amended to support the inclusion of the new Appeals process in policy A136: Academic Integrity. Additionally, changes have been made to remove some contextual guidance that cause misunderstanding for students. The policy did not undergo a full review, the next regular review remains May 2026.

A131 Evaluation of Student Learning

Amended: Nov. 27, 2024 (CC-24-02) Effective: Jan. 1, 2025 and another version effective Sept. 1, 2025

This policy was amended to address two topics:

- 1. The use of AI during the evaluations process, ensuring that student work is not submitted to AI for the purposes of assigning grades.
- 2. A change to provincial requirements regarding fees paid by a student to access an evaluation. Students should not have to pay a separate charge to access any evaluation used in their class unless certain exceptions regarding the unique manner of assessment are applied.
- 3. One section regarding the use of fees to access a test has been approved by College Council, but will not take effect until September 2025 in order to allow schools to amend curriculum where necessary.

The policy did not undergo a full review, the next regular review remains May 2027.

A136 Academic Integrity

Amended: Dec. 18, 2024 (CC-24-03)

This policy has been amended to create a dedicated Appeals process solely for Academic Integrity offences. The policy did not undergo a full review, the next regular review remains May 2026.
